The Skills Connect program can:

- ◆ Assess your skills, qualifications and experience and how these relate to different jobs and occupations in Canada
- ◆ Assist you with career planning and researching different Canadian occupations
- ◆ Help you gain the training and qualifications you need to work in Canada including financial support for training and licensing
- ◆ Connect you with employers and provide you with Canadian work experience
- ◆ Teach you how to find a job in Canada


This program is for individuals:

- ◆ who became a Permanent Resident of Canada in the last *5* years
NOTE: Exceptions may be made up to and including 10 years
- ◆ who are unemployed or under-employed (working at a level below their qualifications or where the job is part-time or seasonal)
- ◆ whose level of English is intermediate or higher
