## ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

EVERY DAY SANCTUARY: THIS POSITION IS FOR THURSDAY, FRIDAY, & SATURDAY 6:30-9:30 AM

- As a part of the team, to open and host early morning space for friends experiencing homelessness, near homelessness and those who need a kind place and a friendly hello.
- Responsible for offering coffee, tea, electrolytes, broth, and other available nourishment.
- Offering quiet rest and a friendly place to be.
- Sit with, converse, and engage friends.
- Responsible to clean at the end of each shift (half an hour at the end of shift from (9-9:30am) SUNRISE SANCTUARY SUNDAY LUNCH PROVIDER.

THIS POSITION IS SUNDAY 6:30 AM- 12:30 PM. (Every Day Sanctuary until 9, and meal until 12:30 PM)

- To prepare lunch for Sunday. This is a hot meal with nutritious content for approximately 50 people total. 36-40 meals are sent out at noon with outreach workers from GMAP and ICMT. Approximately 14 to be served in the hall. (These numbers may change based on the needs of the community and evolution of the position)
- Responsible to prepare and dispense meals, utilizing foods received from Loaves and Fishes Agency Drop.
- To coordinate and work with the team on menu planning and food acquisition.
- Responsible to clean kitchen and dishes .
