You will provide community- driven health and wellness activities, client-focused access to treatment and rehabilitation services for individuals and families experiencing mental health and addictions issues through best practices and clinical health indicators. Preference may be given to qualified applicants who are of Aboriginal ancestry and applicants with direct experience in a recognized Human Service field. The CWW must demonstrate clear professional boundaries and appropriate accountability measures, file-management, charts/records of interventions, and time management.
